At Dover Park Primary School, we expect all our children to wear the correct school uniform each day. "Uniform plays a key role in promoting the ethos of the school, providing a sense of belonging and in setting the appropriate tone for education" (DfE).

***Children in Year 3 will be given the year to transition into KS2 and the KS2 uniform. By the time they start year 4 we will expect all uniform to comply with the KS2 uniform list.**

Children can get very anxious, and sometimes embarrassed, if they do not have the correct items they need for school, including uniform. Please support your child's emotional and mental health by ensuring that you provide your child with the correct uniform.

If you are in financial difficulty and need support with buying uniform please contact Mrs Jackson, our CFLO, who may be able to offer support.

We welcome donations of good quality second hand school uniform that can be passed on to those who need it. We ask that any donations of school uniform are brought to the office.

We have 'Donate and Take' lockers round the side of the school and parents can help themselves to any uniform they need without having to ask. These are open every day at drop off and collection time.

Dover park Primary School understands that it must have regard to its obligations under the Human Rights Act 1998 and The Equality Act 2010. We will always consider pupils who share a protected characteristic e.g. sex, religion/belief, race, disability and gender reassignment. We encourage parents to come and speak to us about such issues so that we are able to reach an agreement about adaptations to school uniform.

The school reserves the right to ask children to remove certain items that are not school uniform, or to ask children to change into school spares if pupils do not comply with our uniform code.



We have endeavoured to keep named items to a minimum in order to keep costs down. We communicate regularly with our supplier in order to keep uniform affordable. Kids &Co also offer a service where the school badge can be fixed to an existing item of clothing for a small cost. We have also taken the decision to provide a free tie to all children as they move into year 3/KS2.

We provide discreet access to good quality second hand uniform in our 'donate and take' lockers.

Trousers/skirt/culottes Pinafore dress	Plain Grey formal. *Children need to be able to sit comfortably and with dignity whilst cross-legged on the floor.	The following are not permitted: leggings, jeggings, treggings, tracksuit bottoms, chinos, skinny, boot cut or nylon fabrics.
Summer dress	Navy blue Gingham	
School coat	Plain, sensible coat or raincoat with a hood	Fashion/denim jackets are not permitted
Socks and Tights	Plain grey school socks/tights	Over knee socks, pop socks and adult tights are not permitted
Shoes	Plain, smart, black sensible school shoes or plain black smart trainers	No boots, high heels, plimsolls or sandals
White polo shirt	Reception & KS1 (Years 1 and 2)	No school logo required
White shirt	Key Stage 2 (Years 3,4,5 and 6)	
Clip on Tie	Years 3-6-Dover Park colours. The first one will be provided by the school. Any replacements are the responsibility of the parent.	
Jewellery	One watch. Small stud earrings.	No other jewellery or piercings are permitted. Earrings must be removed on PE days
Hair styles	Small, plain accessories in navy blue or navy blue gingham. Natural hair colours only.	Extreme hairstyles e.g. coloured hair, large hair accessories, shaved styles or patterns, Mohican styles, extreme gel styles are not permitted
School bag	Backpack and reading bag

Trainers	Plain white with white soles and laces	No logos, ticks, stripes, patterns etc.
PE Shorts	Plain navy blue	No logos, ticks, stripes, patterns etc.
PE T-shirt	Dover Park colours (from Kids & Co) - Plain navy blue with a white shoulder stripe	



Tracksuit, sweat shirt or Jogging bottoms	Plain Navy Blue Jersey.	No logos, ticks, stripes etc.
Jewellery	Must be removed before school on PE Days

- All pupils with long hair, below the collar, should have it tied back.

Please make sure that all your child's school uniform and possessions are clearly named.
