### MATHS

Share objects equally by counting how many in each group. We will be following a catch up curriculum.

### ENGLISH

We will be reading three books this half term.

The Fossil Girl By Catherine Brighton Children will be labelling, writing simple sentences and carrying out role play in order to support their writing.  
Phonics will happen daily and sounds that they have learnt that week will be sent home on a Friday along with a new reading book.
